Dr. Daisuke Asakura is a researcher of Research Institute for Energy Conservation, National Institute of Advanced Industrial Science and Technology (AIST), Japan. He studied solid-state physics and received his Ph.D from The University of Tokyo in 2006. From 2006 to 2009, he studied magnetic properties of spintronic devices as a post-doctoral researcher of Photon Factory, High Energy Accelerator Research Organization (KEK). Since 2009, he has been conducting electronic-structure analyses for electrode materials at AIST. His recent research is *in situ/operando* soft X-ray spectroscopy to clarify the redox reaction in secondary battery.
