Dale Barkey is Professor of Chemical Engineering at the University of New Hampshire in Durham NH, USA. He earned his doctorate in chemical engineering at the University of California at Berkeley and joined the UNH faculty in 1987. His research interests include conductive inks, dissipative pattern formation, electrodeposition for semiconductor packaging, anodizing and corrosion. He has published in the Journal of the Electrochemical Society and Physical Review, and has contributed chapters to two books on electrodeposition. He was Director of the UNH Environmental Engineering Program and has served on the Board of Directors of the Sanford Process Corporation and the Technical Advisory Board of Memgen Corporation.
