## **ENERGY IMPACT OF SUPERCONDUCTORS**



Jacob Rodnizki is a senior scientist at Soreq NRC. He is working at Soreq Applied Research Accelerator (SARAF). SARAF Facility is the first superconducting linac that applied superconducting half Wave Resonators at low beta which is vital for continues Wave (CW) high current linac. Jacob had a fruitful cooperation with RI (former ACCEL) that build phase I of the accelerator (a 4 mA CW 5 MeV proton/ deuteron superconducting accelerator and now he is working in strong cooperation with the national laboratories that are involve in the design of phase II of SARAF (extended for a 5 mA 50 MeV superconducting linac) in the fields of beam dynamics and cavity design.
